Contributions

There are going to be 3 types of sessions you can contribute to:

- **Thematic session (oral presentation):** This is a standard session with talks grouped by a common subject. The format is a **12 min presentation and 3 min discussion.**
- **Trial and Error session (oral presentation):** In this session we want to highlight the work in science that often goes unnoticed - experimental work in progress, methods that did not produce "publishable" results, ideas you have that might or might not be successful, or things you tried but that did not work as expected. The format is **5 min presentation and up to 10 min discussion.** This a great way to gather perspectives from your fellow young geomorphologists or help others avoid making mistakes. This combines the former "spotlight" and "failure session".
- **Poster session:** Your poster should be size **DIN A0 (horizontal or vertical)**. In addition, please prepare a **single-slide presentation** as a teaser for your poster that will be shown at the start of the session.
